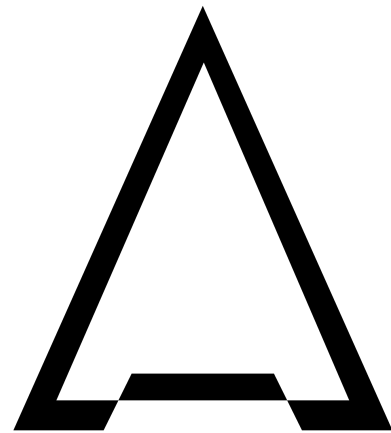

A for Architecture Awards


The **A for Architecture (A4A)** is conceived to be a programme which aims to document and disseminate the A to Z of architecture and the parts that constitute it. It connects architecture to various layers and ideologies of built design playing at various levels. **A4A** stands as a bridge between the budding community of designers who aspire to build design ideas and the best of realized designs that exist in the world.

A4A awards are a part of Uni, a global community of designers and design challenges with more than 100k designers and 500k annual visitors. The entries are judged by a distinguished multidisciplinary jury panel by going through all the entries received. Submissions from architects/designers/interior designers from all around the world are welcomed to this programme.





- A maximum of 8 boards / sheets. – [**2362px x 3544px**] or [**400mm x 600mm in 150 dpi**] in portrait digital format (JPEG).
- Each image should be less than **15MB**

- Ensure that the final sheets which are submitted do not include your name or any other mark of identification.
- Mention sheet number on corner of every sheet.

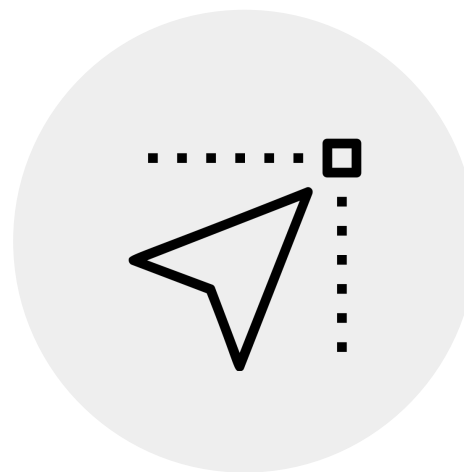

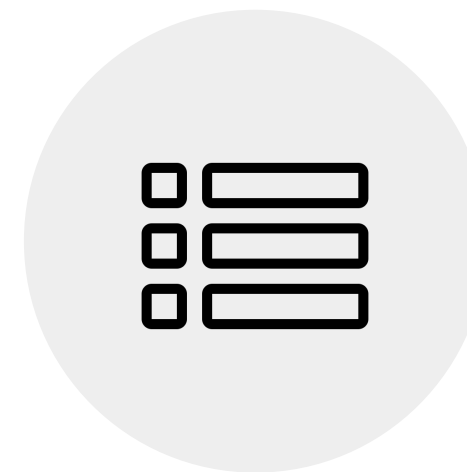
Presentation

Quality of thought and intent in pre-design phase.



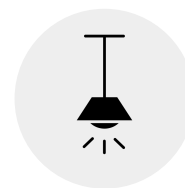
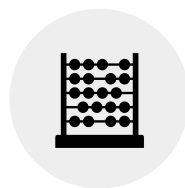
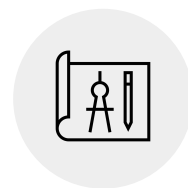
